Kalkidan's father divorced her mother which is a common occurrence within Ethiopia. Culturally this means that the child lives with the mother, virtually abandoned by the father.

Hiwet is originally from Gojam, Northern Ethiopia.

Hiwet went to a cultural doctor during her pregnancy with

Kalkidan. Today, Kalkidan has some hearing problems which may be related to that visit.
